INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUGGESTION OF BANKRUPTCY

Type or print clearly with black ink.

Insert the court on the first line (i.e. County or Circuit); on the second line insert the county and state. Next insert the name(s) of the Plaintiff(s), Defendant(s) and the Case Number.

In the first line of the first paragraph of the body of the form insert the name(s) of the Defendant(s). In the fourth line of the first paragraph insert the district (i.e. Northern, Middle, Southern) and the State for the bankruptcy court where you have filed your bankruptcy petition. Next insert the case number which has been assigned to your bankruptcy case and the date your bankruptcy petition was filed with the bankruptcy court.

In the second paragraph of the body of the form insert the name and address of the plaintiff(s), or if they are represented by an attorney, insert the attorney's name and address. Put a check mark in the appropriate space to indicate whether service on the plaintiff(s) or their attorney is to be by mail or hand delivery.

Sign at the place indicated and insert your name, address and telephone number underneath your signature.

Mail or hand deliver the original to the Clerk of Court where the lawsuit originated, mail or hand deliver a copy to the plaintiff/attorney and keep a copy for your records.
